

## Scholarships from Christchurch Educated.

There are 10 x \$3,500 scholarships that will be awarded to full year fee paying international students who have applied for admission to a Christchurch Educated high school by November 1<sup>st</sup> 2013. These scholarships are based on merit and are available to students applying for any Christchurch Educated high school. There are 3 broad categories

- Academic
- Sport
- Art (creative and performing)

### Christchurch Educated Senior Academic Scholarships.

These can be for any academic discipline a school wishes to promote. The application criteria include;

- School Reports for the most recent 2 years
- Copies of any academic awards
- A recommendation from the student's current school
- A letter in English from the student, outlining their Academic Achievements and why they would benefit from a Christchurch Educated scholarship.

### Christchurch Educated Sport Scholarships.

These are for main stream sports or outdoor education programmes where schools have a recognised development programme in place. The application criteria include;

- School Reports for the most recent 2 years
- Copies of any Awards the student has received in the past 3 years
- A recommendation from the student's coach
- At least one video clip (this can be loaded on YouTube) of the student showing their skill and participation in their sport.

### Christchurch Educated Art Scholarships.

These can be in Music, Visual Art, Drama or Dance. The application criteria include;

- School Reports for the most recent 2 years
- Copies of any Awards or examinations the student has passed
- A recommendation from the student's current arts related teacher
- Video clips of at least one performance (for Music, Dance or Drama)
- Photos of examples of the student's work (for Art)

## Application Process

The same application process applies to both junior and senior scholarships are as follows;

- 1 Students must complete an International Student Application form for the school they wish to attend, and scan or post it to the International Director at their chosen school by November 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 2 Late applications will not be accepted.
- 3 Individual schools will screen the applications they receive and submit them with the school's recommendations to a Christchurch Educated review panel by the deadline date (November 8<sup>th</sup>).
- 4 Scholarship recipients will be selected by Christchurch Educated, with the recommendation of a committee consisting of a representative member International Director and Faculty Head or Teacher in Charge of Sport.
- 5 Scholarship recipients will be notified via email one week after the deadline date.
- 6 Scholarships are awarded for one year only and the scholarship will be deducted from the recipient's school fees paid by the student for that year.

7 If there are no applicants of suitable calibre for a particular scholarship, then no award will be made.

8 Scholarship students are expected to contribute to their school's International Department throughout the year acting as ambassadors for the school, its International Department and Christchurch Educated. This may include: being called on for Christchurch Educated promotional events, translating for new students, showing families around their school, writing blogs or taking photos of their experiences at school, etc.

9 If the scholarship recipient withdraws from their chosen school, the scholarship will be withdrawn.

### **Conditions**

Applicants cannot be citizens of New Zealand or Australia or have a parent who has a working visa in New Zealand or is intending to apply for one. All scholarship winners will be required to provide evidence of proficiency in English. These scholarships are not available to students applying to any other Christchurch Educated incentive programme i.e. the Rayong / Chonburi relationship
